

KEYpak+1 Viewer uses KEYpak to convert the document to WPS\_PLUS format and then display it. This document can be edited and saved in the ALL-IN-1 file cabinet in a user's format of choice. This document can now be sent to an external destination using the ALL-IN-1 forms and the KEYpak+1 menu items.

### Features

- Send an external document, existing in a VMS directory or on a personal computer emulating an ALL-IN-1 workstation, to each addressee listed in the message header.
- Read a message. If an external document is attached to the message, you have the option of transferring the external document to a VMS directory, a personal computer emulating an ALL-IN-1 workstation, or to your ALL-IN-1 file cabinet.
- Attach an external document, existing in a VMS directory or on a personal computer emulating an ALL-IN-1 workstation, to the current document in the file cabinet - usually a message header created with the C (create) option.
- If more than one external document is attached to the message, you have the option of transferring the external documents to a VMS directory, a personal computer emulating an ALL-IN-1 workstation, or to your ALL-IN-1 file cabinet.
- Edit an external document using an ALL-IN-1 editor. After editing, the document will be saved in its original format.
- Provide transfer protocols necessary for up and down loading file between the ALL-IN-1 file cabinet and other storage devices such as Personal Computers.
